During the first six months of the project and after a series of online meetings, discussions and preparations, we have released a Call for Artists from 31.01.21 to 15.03.21, looking for 4 artists that will collaborate with our team in the development of art-based activities for the IMPROVISA workshops and the IMPROVISA App, during 2021 and 2022. We have received 36 proposals and after a hard choice based on criteria such as the ideas for the IMPROVISA project and artistic background, we are glad to announce the selected artists that will collaborate in **IMPROVISA-Life in Motion**.
